

First class will start around 9.30am (depending on entries).

Judges: Delheas Lucas and Gail Walkinshaw

CLASS 1: BD INTRO 2 - Horse not to have won at Prelim or above and/or three firsts at INTRO. Spurs not allowed.

CLASS 2: BD Preliminary 3 (2024) - Horse & Rider combinations not to have won 3 firsts at Restricted Prelim level or above.

CLASS 3: BD Preliminary 1 (2024) Open.

CLASS 4: BD Novice 2 (2024) Horse & Rider combinations not to have won 3 firsts at Restricted Novice level or above.

CLASS 5: BD Novice 1 (2024) Open.

CLASS 6: BD Elementary 1 (2024).

CLASS 7: BD Medium 1 (2024).

Indoor warm up, outdoor test.

- I. The Walk Trot (INTRO) test WILL BE LIMITED to the first 15 entries received. Other classes may be limited to ensure completion of the show at a reasonable time.
- II. Classes may be limited to ensure completion of schedule. EDRC members will receive guaranteed entry, but please do not leave entry until the last minute, non-member entries will be taken on a 'first come, first served' basis.

Entry Fees : EDRC Members £15.00, Non-members £17.00.

Times will be made available on the EDRC Facebook page and horsemonkey on the evening of Thursday 23rd October.

This competition is open to non-riding club members however is restricted to riders aged 16 years & over. All riders must hold third party insurance.

Please be courteous and ensure you leave the venue as you found it, including parking areas (see rule 18).



Rules

- 1) All horses to be age 4yrs and over and all riders to be aged 16 years or over.
- 2) Horses may not be entered in more than **3** classes (including HC).
- 3) A horse/rider combination entering Class 1 cannot enter Classes 5, 6 or 7 (and vice versa).
- 4) A horse/rider combination entering Class 2 cannot enter Class 6 or 7 (and vice versa).
- 5) Strictly no dogs.
- 6) This competition is run under British Riding Club rules 2022.
- 7) Rider must wear 'Protective headwear' (a hard hat) which meets one of the following standards: PAS 015: 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked; or
 - VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked;
 - ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked; 0r
 - SNELL E2016 (must have official SNELL label and number; or
 - AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

*From 1 January 2023 the PAS 015: 1998 and SNELL E2001 are no longer be accepted

- 8) Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the showground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 9) Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
- 10) EDRC members will receive league table points in all classes (members entering multiple classes will only receive points for placings in the highest level 2 classes (e.g. if entering the 70cm, 80cm and 90cm, only placings in the 80cm and 90cm will count towards league points). Memberships must be fully paid up by closing date of entries to qualify for points. LEAGUE POINTS WILL ONLY COUNT TOWARDS FINAL LEAGUE PLACING IF THE MEMBER HAS HELPED AT AT LEAST 1 EDRC RUN EVENT IN THE CALENDAR YEAR.
- 11) The judge's decision is final. Any complaints must be made in writing to the secretary within 24 hours of results being published.
- 12) No refunds after entries close, unless the show is cancelled by EDRC. An administration fee may be taken from each competitor.
- 13) Riding Club rules for area competitions apply, dressage tests may be read.
- 14) Cantering is allowed only in practice and competition areas.
- 15) The organisers reserve the right to combine or split classes according to entries with results determined on a percentage basis.
- 16) There will be a limited number of entries available in each class.
- 17) Spurs are no longer allowed in Intro tests.
- 18) Horses /ponies should be vaccinated against Equine Flu according to BRC rules.
- 19) ******PLEASE NOTE, use of this venue is subject to certain terms, one of which is that the venue, including the parking area, must be left clean & tidy. As a result, ANY ENTRANTS NOT LEAVING THE PARKING AREAS AS THEY FOUND THEM WILL NOT HAVE FUTURE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. PLEASE THEREFORE ENSURE YOU REMOVE ALL HAY/DROPPINGS/LITTER ETC.
